BOIL WATER ALERT LIFTED

The Westchester County Department of Health and the Mt. Pleasant Water District today announced that the “boil water” alert issued for the Hawthorne Improvement District has been lifted as of 2:30 p.m.

Following coliform sampling that was done throughout the district on December 22, the Health Department has determined that the water in the distribution system meets all applicable state standards and is safe for public consumption. The alert, which affected approximately 4,500 residents, was put into place on Saturday, December 21, following a water main break at Frankfort and Willis Avenue in Hawthorne.
