

Senior Programs and Services

The County is home to over 167,000 older people—with one-in-five residents 60 years of age or older. The aging population is projected to surge over the next few decades as the Baby Boom population ages.

This chapter highlights the programs and services that make it possible for older adults to remain in their homes with independence and dignity. In addition, this chapter provides a listing of senior housing facilities and local senior programs in Westchester County.

The following are services in Westchester made available through a network of countywide, regional and local providers:

- Access services include information and assistance, case management, outreach, a telephone reassurance program, nutrition, site transportation, supportive services transportation, a volunteer transportation service and Project Quality of Life Congregate Transportation.
- Community-based support services include home energy assistance, weatherization, legal services, housing assistance, senior ID cards, crime prevention/victims' assistance, enrichment programs and the emergency medical package for seniors.
- Employment services under Title V of the Older American Act (the Senior Community Service Employment Project) include job recruitment conducted for all older persons and job readiness training provided under the Workforce Investment Act.
- Food and Nutrition Services include congregate meals, home delivered meals, nutrition education and nutrition counseling.

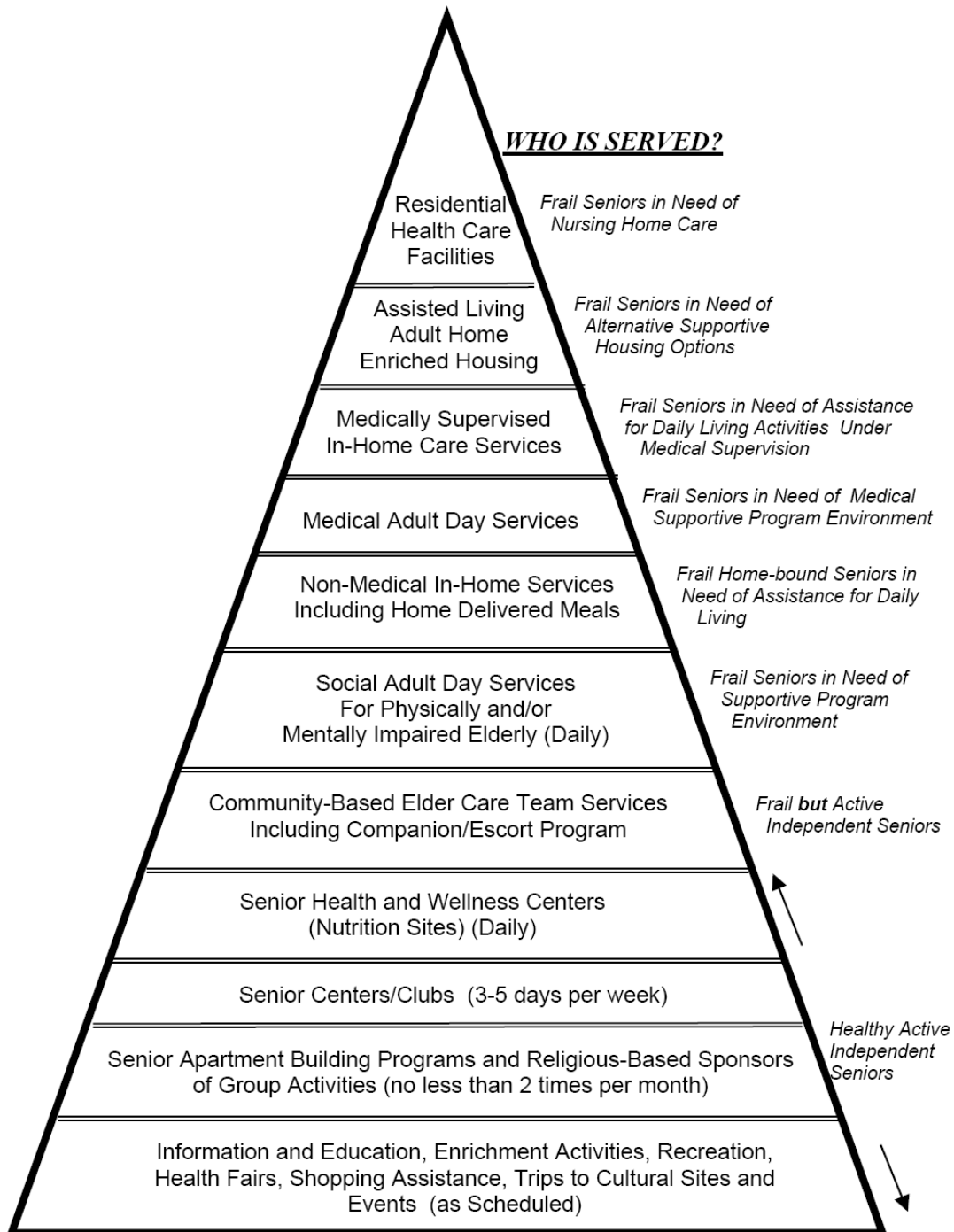
Community-based long-term care services include in-home services such as homemaker, housekeeper, home delivered meals, respite services, ancillary services, the Family Caregiver Support Program and caregiver resource centers, nursing home ombudsman program, social adult day services programs and Medicare insurance information.

Programs and Services

Case Management

A comprehensive process that helps older people gain access to and coordinates appropriate services, benefits and entitlements through the use of a standardized process of assessment and re-assessment, care planning, arranging for services, follow-up monitoring, reassessment and discharge.

Food and Nutrition Services

The Nutrition Program provides meals that are served at congregate sites throughout the County and through the home delivered meals program. Meals are provided five or more days per week at approved nutrition sites and multi-purpose centers throughout the County and to home-bound elderly who are unable to participate at congregate sites.

Employment Services

The Senior Community Services Employment Project (SCSEP) promotes part-time employment for persons who are fifty-five years of age and older who are on a limited income. Enrollees are employed in a wide variety of positions through which they receive training and gain experience that will assist them in transitioning to private or other unsubsidized employment.

Legal Services

Westchester County Department of Senior Programs and Services subcontracts with a county-wide legal services agency to provide legal assistance to those senior citizens within the County with the most pressing legal needs, who do not have access to attorneys, face financial barriers or are physical unable to seek legal services.

Senior ID Cards

County residents age 60 or older, are encouraged to apply for the Westchester County Senior Citizen ID Card. There is a nominal fee of \$4.00 that includes the cost of the photo, handling and mailing. The card serves as a lifetime residence permit and entitles its holder to discounts with many merchants and, at age 65 to reduced fares on bus rides during non-rush hours.

Emergency Medical Package

When an emergency occurs in the home, the ability to receive all the medical information quickly can help to save a life. This document, which filled out, will provide emergency medical personnel with important and adequate information that can expedite treatment. This document will also help caregivers provide valuable information to the medical staff if the senior is unable to do so.

Energy Assistance

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) has been developed to help low-income households meet the increasing costs of fuel and utilities. Eligibility is based on income and guidelines change each year. Grants have also been made for emergency situations. A special mail-in application is available for those 60 years of age and older. The program usually begins in the fall.

Housing Counseling

Counseling and referral to participating financial institutions is available to homeowners age 60 and over who wish to borrow the equity from their homes. The Reverse Mortgage Program allows homeowners to supplement their income or to finance home improvements while they continue to own and occupy their home. Eligible homeowners can take a loan against the appraised value of the home, which will generate a monthly income for the term of the loan. Through the Shared Housing Program, homeowners willing to share their homes are matched with compatible tenants on a peer-centered or Cross-generational basis in order to reduce living expenses and have companionship.

Enrichment and Recreation Programs

A variety of educational and enrichment programs are available for older adult groups at nutrition sites, senior clubs and centers, apartment buildings and in other congregate settings. The purpose of these programs is to enlighten and provide intellectual stimulation. Programs offered include health education; historical and cultural programs, including bus trips, music and art appreciation, living history, voter education, consumer awareness, and safety programs.

Livable Community Connection

The Livable Community Connection involves nine new regional centers that help seniors to "age in place" by staying in their homes and communities, but with access to supportive services, affordable housing, and transportation. COUNTY-BASED LONG TERM CARE SERVICES

In-Home Services

Homemaker/Personal Care services are provided to chronically ill individuals who have varying degrees of functional impairment in activities of daily living (bathing, eating, toileting, dressing, transferring and continence), and in instrumental activities of daily living (meal preparation, housekeeping, shopping, telephone use, travel, money management, and taking medications). In-Home services are provided by licensed agencies.

Respite Services

In-home respite services are provided in the home for families caring for a frail elderly member. Respite provides a temporary time-out from the care-giving responsibilities of a dependent family member. Families requesting respite services are matched with a trained "sitter-companion".

Ancillary Services

The Personal Emergency Response System (PERS) is a system by which a senior in need of help can press a "call button" to reach and speak to a response center. If help is needed, response center staff will call pre-arranged persons for assistance or, if no one is available, will call local police, ambulance or fire department for help. Family Caregiver Support Program and Caregiver Resource Centers

The Family Caregiver Support Program will provide access services to caregivers, organiza-

tions and support groups through Westchester County library Caregiver Resource Centers. The Family Caregiver Support Program will provide access services to caregivers, organizations and support groups through Caregiver Resource Centers located throughout Westchester.

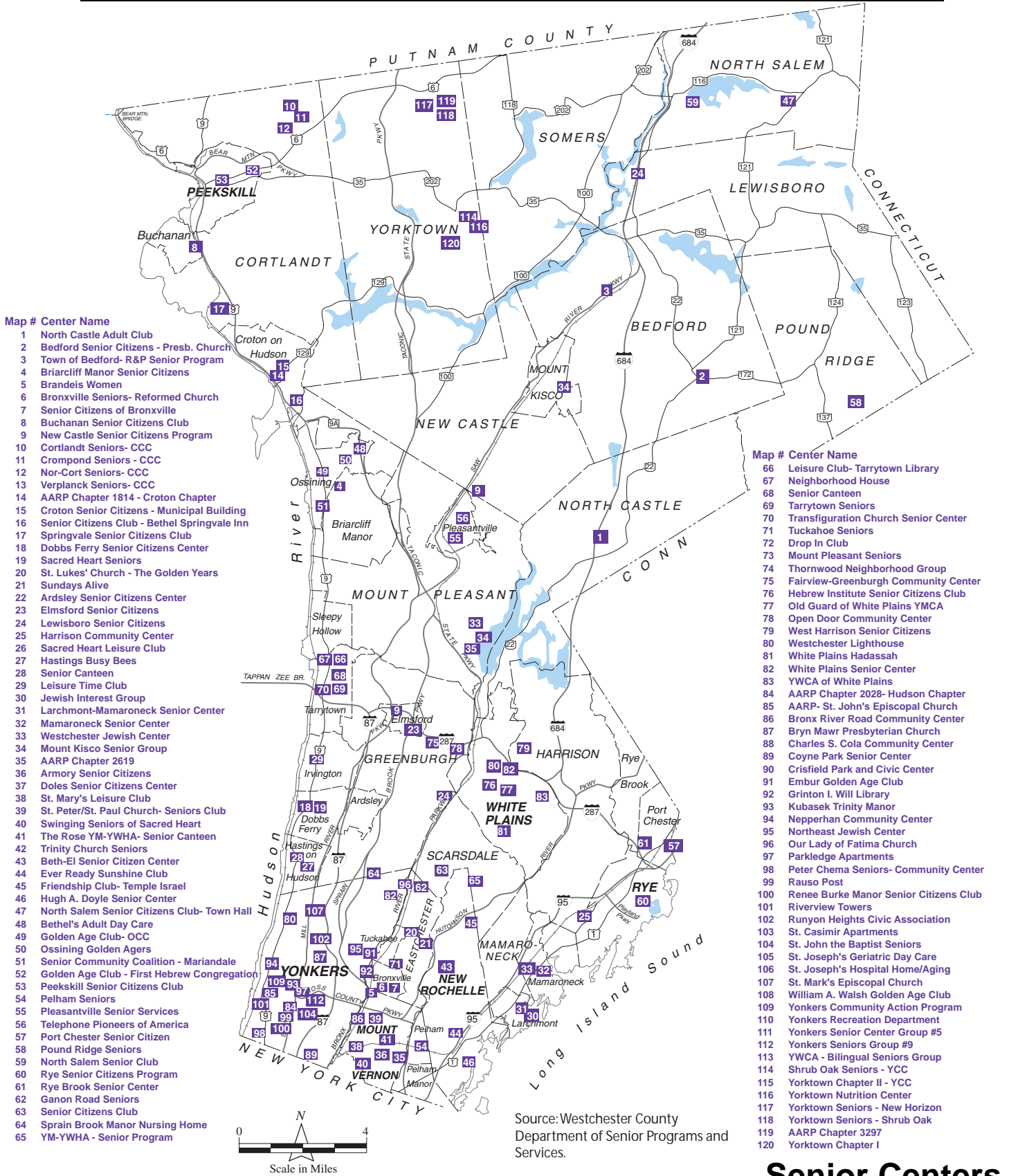

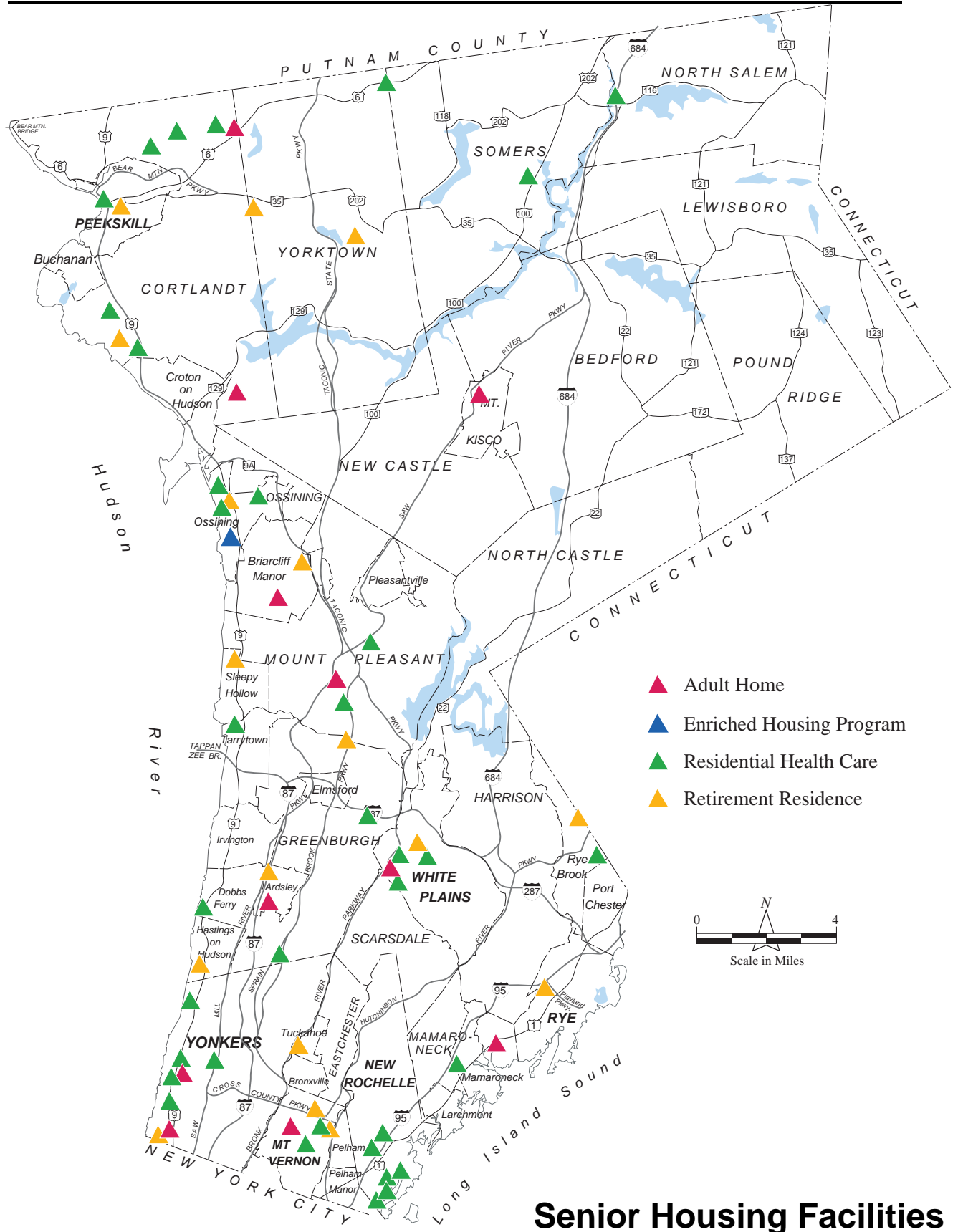
