

**International Walk to School Day  
King Street School, Port Chester  
October 3, 2007**

The King Street Elementary School in Port Chester joined schools from around the world in celebration of **International Walk to School Day**.

Approximately 146 students walked to school Wednesday morning along with parents, teachers and community leaders. Mayor Dennis Pilla, Assemblyman George Latimer, and Board of Education representative James Dreves were on hand to greet students.

The event began at 8:00am when children, parents and community leaders left home to walk to school. At 8:30 am, the entire school walked around the school building (a distance of 0.39 miles), giving children who rode the bus a chance to participate. Fifth graders wore pedometers provided by Westchester County's Fit Kids program.
