**SUSPICIOUS LETTER THAT WAS SENT TO CONGRESSWOMAN SUE KELLY  
TESTS NEGATIVE FOR ANTHRAX**

The Westchester County Department of Health today announced that laboratory test results have determined that a suspicious letter sent to Congresswoman Sue Kelly's Mt. Kisco office is negative for anthrax. In light of the negative test results, it is not necessary for anyone to be placed on antibiotic treatment and most offices at 116 Radio Circle Drive, Mt. Kisco have been reopened. Due to the ongoing criminal investigation, Congresswoman Kelly's office remains closed and the letter has been turned over to the FBI for further evaluation.
