In recognition of National Drinking Water Week, county residents participated in a blind taste test at the Michaelian Office Building, 148 Martine Avenue, White Plains, on Wednesday, May 5, to select their favorite drinking water. Approximately 110 participants tasted water from the Village of Croton-on-Hudson, City of Yonkers, City of Mount Vernon, Greenburgh, and City of White Plains.

Yonkers was voted the best tasting water followed by Greenburgh, Croton-on-Hudson, Mt. Vernon and White Plains. The winner of this contest goes on to compete in the New York State water tasting contest.

“Water Week” is a coordinated effort of the Westchester County Water Agency, the Westchester County Department of Health, the Westchester Water Works Conference, the New York Section of the American Water Works Association and the New York State Department of Health.
