BOIL WATER ADVISORY LIFTED

The Westchester County Department of Health today lifted the “boil water” advisory for Yonkers residents who lost water or experienced low water pressure in the wake of this weekend’s storms. The Health Department bacteriological tests of the water system today confirmed that the drinking water quality is satisfactory under New York State drinking water guidelines.

The “boil water” advisory was issued on September 3, 2006 for Yonkers residents who lost water or experienced low water pressure in the wake of this weekend’s storms. The “boil water” advisory was a precautionary measure to protect residents from any bacteria that may have entered the drinking water due to the loss of water pressure.
