**HUDSON RIVER ADVISORY LIFTED**

The Westchester County Department of Health today announced that the alert issued for boaters, marinas and recreational water users of the Hudson River has been lifted. The Health Department has determined that the water is now safe for recreational use and no longer poses a public health risk.

The alert was put into place on Friday, May 4, due to a major sewage line break at the Greystone Train Station in Yonkers which resulted in the discharge of untreated sewage into the river.
