**BOIL WATER ORDER LIFTED**

The Westchester County Department of Health has lifted the mandatory "boil water" order issued for Westchester Joint Water Works customers in the West Harrison Silver Lake area.

Following water sampling results and consultation with the New York State Department of Health, it has been determined that the water in the distribution system is safe for public consumption. The "boil water" order was put into place by the Westchester County Department of Health on Saturday, May 12, because unchlorinated water had been delivered into the system.
