Yonkers municipal water wins Westchester water tasting contest during water week

The Westchester County Department of Health held its annual water tasting contest today in White Plains, where residents sampled water from six of the County's water suppliers and proclaimed Yonkers their favorite.

The blind taste test was held in recognition of National Drinking Water Week outside of the Michaelian Office Building on Martine Avenue from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. One hundred sixty three people sampled water from United Water New Rochelle; Yonkers Water Supply; Westchester County District No. 3, which provides water to parts of Valhalla; Village of Croton-on-Hudson; Elmsford and Town of Greenburgh.

Yonkers received the most votes, 45, and the runner-up was Greenburgh, with 35 votes.
