LITARGIRIO is a yellow- or peach-colored powder manufactured in the Dominican Republic and often used as a deodorant, a foot fungicide, a treatment for burns and wound healing, and for other purposes as a traditional remedy. LITARGIRIO contains lead and can cause your family to become sick with lead poisoning.

Children with lead poisoning may not show any signs of being sick but can suffer permanent neurological damage.

- **Stop all use of LITARGIRO immediately.**
- **Thoroughly wash hands and any other body parts that may have come in contact with the powder. Wash affected household surfaces with soap and hot water.**
