DEPUTY COMMISSIONER OF CORRECTION

Westchester County Government is actively searching for qualified candidates for *Deputy Commissioner of Correction*. The Westchester County Department of Correction (WCDOC) serves the public by providing an efficient, secure and humane means of detaining individuals with criminal matters pending in Westchester County.

Under the general direction of the Commissioner of Correction, and in accordance with New York State Commission of Correction rules and regulations and applicable federal, state and local laws, the incumbent in this position assists in the direction and administration of the Westchester County Department of Correction. This position acts on behalf of the Commissioner and serves as acting Commissioner in the absence of the Commissioner. Responsibilities include: custody and security of inmates and the development of administrative, educational and rehabilitation programs.

Preference will be given to those candidates who possess a Bachelor's Degree in correctional administration or an allied field (e.g. criminology, sociology) and nine years of increasingly responsible uniformed experience in correctional administration or a related administrative field, to include security and/or custodial functions, budget preparation and program development. A Master's Degree in Correctional Administration, Criminology, Sociology, or a closely related field, may be substituted on a year for year basis for up to two years of the above stated experience.

Compensation: The Deputy Commissioner of Correction is an Executive Level appointed position with a competitive salary. The compensation package includes comprehensive benefits, including medical, dental, vision, deferred compensation, paid leave and NYS retirement plan.
