HEATING PLANT OPERATORS

The Westchester County Department of Public Works and Transportation is seeking Heating Plant Operators to work at the County's central heating plant located in Valhalla, New York. Vacancies currently exist for all three shifts at this high pressure plant that provides heating and cooling for 2.5 million square feet of combined-use facilities situated on a 500-acre campus. The plant services the Westchester County Medical Center, Maria Ferrari Children's Hospital, the Westchester County Correctional facility and the Department of Labs and Research.

Westchester County is only 30 miles north of New York City with the Long Island Sound on the southeast and the Hudson River on the west. Westchester County offers a compensation package that includes comprehensive medical, dental, vision benefits, deferred compensation, paid leave and the NYS retirement plan.
