

CHIEF OF SECTION (RENAL DISEASE)

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under the general supervision of the director of Division (Renal Laboratory), is responsible for testing feasibility and cost of Home Hemodialysis with the training of patients as a primary goal. Partial supervision is exercised over a small staff of professional and technical employees. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Exercises overall responsibility for planning and supervision of individualized training of patients;

Is responsible for the training, education, follow-up and evaluation of personnel assigned;

Assists the Director in administrative duties;

Gives general supervision to the work of the Financial Administrator of this unit;

Coordinates inter-divisional liaisons with other clinical divisions;

Assists in planning, carrying out and evaluating research activities, and in preparing periodic evaluations and reports as required;

Assists in establishing improved facilities.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGES, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Comprehensive knowledge of the principles and techniques of renal physiology; good knowledge of internal medicine; skill in use of ancillary, chemical, physical and electronic equipment of renal functions; ability to plan, instruct and supervise the work of others; ability to investigate new problems and to assemble and evaluate experimental evidence; good judgment; initiative; thoroughness; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: A Degree as a Doctor of Medicine and completion for an approved internship, three years of approved residency training in internal medicine, and one additional year of training or practice.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT: License to practice medicine in New York State.

*SPECIAL NOTE: Education beyond the secondary level must be from an institution recognized or accredited by the Board of Regents of the New York State Department of Education as a post-secondary, degree-granting institution.
