CLEANER

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: Under supervision, performs manual work involved in cleaning and caring for public buildings, adjacent yards and sidewalks. The Cleaner works several nights a week. The work of a Cleaner is distinguished from Caretaker in that a person in this position is not required to perform handyman repairs or care for furnaces. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Mops floors, corridors, and stairs;

Cleans lavatories;

Dusts desks, chairs, tables, bookshelves, and filing cabinets;

Empties trash receptacles;

Waxes furniture and floors;

Washes windows, walls, and partitions;

Vacuums floors, rugs and carpets;

Moves furniture;

Mows lawns:

May shovel snow, clean sidewalks, yards, and driveways.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Familiarity with building cleaning practices, supplies, and equipment; ability to use building cleaning supplies and equipment; ability to understand and follow simple oral and written instruction; willingness to perform manual tasks; thoroughness; dependability; honesty; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: There are no minimum requirements of training and experience.
