ENGINEERING TECHNICIAN (SURVEY)

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: Under supervision, an incumbent of this class works as a general field assistant, usually as rodman or chainman in a survey party, but may occasionally be called upon to work inside doing simple computations or elementary drafting. Supervision is not a responsibility of this position. Does related work as required.
