

FIRST AID NURSE

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: Under general supervision has responsible charge of all First Aid Stations at Playland; and does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: This position involves responsibility for rendering first aid in emergencies to all employees and patrons of Playland.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Gives first aid treatment to employees and patrons;

Is responsible for requisitioning supplies for first aid stations;

Makes decisions regarding the First-Aid Service at Playland;

Is responsible for calling a physician or sending patients to the hospital when required;

Keeps a complete record of all injuries treated and makes out forms for liability and compensation cases.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES, AND ATTRIBUTES: Thorough knowledge of First Aid practice and procedures; ability to size up people and situations and adopt an effective course of action; carefulness; good judgment in rendering First Aid, good physical condition; ability to get along well with others.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: Three years of nursing experience and graduation from a school of nursing recognized by the State Board of Examiners of Nurses in the State in which the school is located.

ADDITIONAL REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS: Possession of a New York State Professional Nurses License.
