DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under supervision of an attendant of higher rank, performs various duties in the operation of refreshment stands, bathhouses, games, boating facilities, amusement devices and rest rooms. Supervision is not a responsibility of this position, although oversight may be exercised over the work of others. This is a seasonal position. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Serves food at refreshment stands and collects money for same;

Checks clothing at bathhouse:

Rents bathing suits, towels, umbrellas and beach chairs;

Provides public with change for coin machines;

Assists in the operation of amusement devices, such as shooting galleries;

Rents boats and canoes:

Maintains boats and canoes:

Supervises kiddie playground;

Maintains rest rooms and makes change.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions; ability to make change rapidly and accurately; ability to get along with coworkers and public; courtesy; tact; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
