## MEDICAL FELLOW (POST GRADUATE YEAR VI - VIII)

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: Under the direct supervision of a Clinical Division Director, this position is designed to provide clinical training in a specialized field of medicine beyond residency. Medical research is performed in this position. Does related work as required.

**EXAMPLES OF WORK**: (Illustrative Only)

Performs and analyzes medical research in a specialized field of medicine;

Renders medical care to patients of the Westchester County Medical Center;

Instructs medical and technical staff;

Prepares reports on clinical and laboratory research work;

Keeps statistics on patient treatments and research work;

Attends conferences, staff meetings and seminars;

Conducts conferences among medical staff on research findings.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Thorough knowledge of the modern techniques and principles of medicine; good knowledge of the modern drugs and their uses in the treatment of diseases; familiarity with the modern techniques of laboratory testing; ability to diagnose and treat illnesses; ability to carry out complex oral and/or written instructions; understanding in dealing with patients; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: Possession of a M.D. Degree\*, and one year of an approved internship and two years of approved residency.

<u>SPECIAL REQUIREMENT</u>: License or eligibility for license to practice medicine in New York State.

\*SPECIAL NOTE: Education beyond the secondary level must be from an institution recognized or accredited by the Board of Regents of the New York State Department of Education as a post-secondary, degree-granting institution.
