NON-INVASIVE TECHNICIAN TRAINEE

<u>GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES</u> : Develops the skills of a Non-Invasive Technician through one-the-job training; does related work as required.

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: Under the supervision of a cardiologist, this person is intended to develop those skills in an employee prerequisite to appropriately conducting a variety of complex cardiological tests, and those abilities necessary to properly prepare tests for evaluation by a cardiologist. This is an on-the-job training position, and assists trained technicians in their work.

Conducts Phonocardiography recordings;

Conducts Vectorcardiography recordings;

Conducts Echocardiography recordings;

Processes test recording films;

Cuts and mounts recordings;

Prepares reports on patient testing as required;

Provides doctors with information with regard to patient tests as requested.
