

STARTER-GOLF COURSE

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under supervision, of Golf Course Manager, has responsibility for starting players on rounds at a County golf course, according to a schedule, in a regular and safe order. Incumbents patrol the course to maintain speed of play and to prevent violation of the rules and regulations governing play. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Receives and checks golfers' tickets, preventing those without tickets from playing the course;

Starts players at first tee and tenth tee according to schedule;

Establishes a safe period of time between starting golfers and maintains tee-time intervals;

Observes and reports conditions that might be hazardous to the golfing public;

Informs golfers of the rules and regulations;

Relieves congested playing conditions which may arise on the course;

Picks up litter as necessary;

Takes round time surveys when necessary;

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Good knowledge of the rules and regulations of golf play on a County golf course; ability to read and write; ability to be courteous and firm with the public; ability to command respect and to maintain discipline; alertness; tact; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: There are no minimum requirements.
