## STARTER-GOLF COURSE

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: Under supervision, of Golf Course Manager, has responsibility for starting players on rounds at a County golf course, according to a schedule, in a regular and safe order. Incumbents patrol the course to maintain speed of play and to prevent violation of the rules and regulations governing play. Does related work as required.

## **EXAMPLES OF WORK**: (Illustrative Only)

Receives and checks golfers' tickets, preventing those without tickets from playing the course;

Starts players at first tee and tenth tee according to schedule;

Establishes a safe period of time between starting golfers and maintains tee-time intervals;

Observes and reports conditions that might be hazardous to the golfing public;

Informs golfers of the rules and regulations;

Relieves congested playing conditions which may arise on the course;

Picks up litter as necessary;

Takes round time surveys when necessary;

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Good knowledge of the rules and regulations of golf play on a County golf course; ability to read and write; ability to be courteous and firm with the public; ability to command respect and to maintain discipline; alertness; tact; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: There are no minimum requirements.
