

## SUPERVISING ATTENDANT - PLAYLAND

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under supervision of the Bathhouse Manager, an incumbent is responsible for activities at the Playland bathhouse during the summer season. An incumbent functions as a working supervisor over a number of lower level attendants. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Assigns and supervises work of Bathhouse Attendants;

Supervises rental of lockers and bathing items, such as towels and bathing suits;

Settles public complaints and disputes;

Insures that supply levels are maintained;

Prepares and submits reports on bathhouse activities and revenue received.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Good knowledge of the public bathhouse operations; ability to plan, lay out, and supervise the work of others; ability to deal effectively with the public; initiative; courtesy; tact; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: Either (a) high school or equivalency diploma and 3 years experience in a public bathhouse or similar facility.
