

LABORER
(SCHOOL DISTRICTS)

GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES: Performs unskilled indoor and outdoor manual labor; does related work as required.

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under direct supervision, this class is responsible for performing a variety of unskilled tasks, usually on the grounds. Custodian duties are usually only a small part of the assignment. Supervision is not a responsibility of this class.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Rakes leaves;

Trims shrubbery and trees;

Cuts, weeds, and rakes grass;

Washes windows;

Shovels snow;

Assists in heavy work in kitchen and cafeteria;

Moves furniture and equipment;

Assists in building and equipment maintenance and repair.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Ability to understand and carry out oral instructions; ability to work well with others; good physical strength and endurance; physical condition commensurate with the duties of the position.

MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE: None.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENT FOR APPOINTMENT IN SCHOOL DISTRICTS:
