MAINTENANCE MECHANIC (ICE RINK)

<u>GENERAL STATEMENT OF DUTIES</u>: Performs maintenance work on the Town of Mamaroneck Ice Rink; does related work as required.

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: Under the direct supervision of the Superintendent of Recreation, performs a wide variety of maintenance work generally, but not exclusively, on the air conditioning, refrigeration and low pressure heating plant of the Town of Mamaroneck Ice Rink. This position may serve in a supervisory capacity or work independently on complex assignments that may be initiated by oral instructions or written work orders. The Maintenance Mechanic (Ice Rink) may be required to provide instruction in the maintenance of the Ice Rink. Supervision may be exercised over a small staff of seasonal and/or part-time recreation personnel.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Operates and maintains ice rink refrigeration or air conditioning plant;

Operates and maintains Zamboni Ice Re-conditioning Machine;

Inspects and adjusts temperature controls, and other devices;

Operates and maintains ice skate sharpening machine;

Repairs pipes and duct work;

Performs emergency electrical, plumbing and other miscellaneous repair work as required;

Solicits and promotes rental of ice time;

Supervises and promotes hockey and figure skating programs;

Supervises, operates and maintains Air Structure;

Supervises the installation and removal of Air Structure and Ice Rink;

<u>REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES</u>: Comprehensive knowledge of the operation, maintenance and repair techniques necessary for the efficient operation of refrigeration air conditioning machinery and the Zamboni Ice Re-conditioning machinery; comprehensive knowledge of the safety precautions of the trade; good knowledge of electrical, plumbing and steam fitting work; ability to act quickly and efficiently in the event of mechanical failure; ability to follow complex oral and written instructions and maintain intelligible and meaningful records; ability to impart mechanical knowledge to others and coordinate effort with other employees; ability to instruct others in physical activities (skating,); physical strength and agility; physical condition commensurate with the duties of the position.

MAINTENANCE MECHANIC (ICE RINK)

<u>MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE</u>: Either (a) graduation from high school or trade school or possession of an equivalency diploma and three years experience in the maintenance and repair of refrigeration, air conditioning or ice rink equipment; or (b) graduation from a two year post high or trade school course and three years of experience as stated in (a); or (c) a satisfactory equivalent combination of the foregoing training and experience.
