

ROAD MAINTAINER

DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS: Under direct supervision, an incumbent in this class performs routine manual work in the repairing and resurfacing of roads. This work requires no previous training or experience, but requires physical endurance and willingness to perform menial tasks in the repair and maintenance of roads. Constant oversight is maintained over work at all times. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Assists with road building, paving, and other road maintenance activities such as patching, leveling, grading, spreading tar, painting lines, and raking asphalt;

Assists with snow removal and plowing, sanding, and salting of roads and the erection and removal of snow fences;

Assists in the construction, cleaning, and repairing of ditches, drains, culverts, trenches, catch basins, and sanitary sewers;

Trims trees, hedges, bushes and cuts up trees that have been felled in the municipal right of way;

Assists with raking topsoil and spreading seed and hay;

May perform other incidental tasks as needed.

REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES: Ability to work outdoors in all weather conditions; ability to lift heavy weights; ability to use the tools, equipment and terminology used in road maintenance work; ability to follow oral instructions; ability to get along well with others; ability to read, write, understand and communicate in English sufficiently to perform the essential functions of the position; willingness to perform routine manual work; reliability; physical endurance; physical condition commensurate with the demands of the position.
