## WATER MAINTENANCE WORKER - GRADE II

<u>DISTINGUISHING FEATURES OF THE CLASS</u>: Under the immediate supervision of a Water Works Superintendent or other superior (i.e. Distribution Superintendent, Distribution Foreman, or Water Maintenance Worker Grade I), an incumbent of this class performs routine, semi-skilled work which involves the installation, maintenance and repair of water mains, service connections, valves, hydrants, and other facilities of a water distribution system. Incumbent may oversee the work of a small number of laborers. Does related work as required.

EXAMPLES OF WORK: (Illustrative Only)

Assists in the tapping of water mains;

Assists in the installation and repair of water mains, valves and service connections;

Assists in the installation, flushing and repair of fire hydrants;

Operates automotive equipment;

Assists in the investigation of consumer complaints;

Assists in the location of pipes and leaks;

Performs custodial and maintenance work at water plant facilities and properties;

Uses computer applications or other automated systems such as spreadsheets, word processing, calendar, e-mail and database software in performing work assignments.

<u>REQUIRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES AND ATTRIBUTES</u>: Familiarity with the practices, tools, equipment and terminology involved in the installation, maintenance and repair of a water distribution system; ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions; ability to withstand heavy labor for extended periods; industry; dependability; physical condition commensurate with the duties of the position.

<u>MINIMUM ACCEPTABLE TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE</u>: Either: (a) one year of experience as a plumber's helper; or (b) one year of work experience in the operation, maintenance or repair of mechanical equipment; or (c) one year of work experience in the construction field; or (d) one year of experience performing routine manual labor in a water distribution facility or department.

<u>SPECIAL REQUIREMENT AT TIME OF APPOINTMENT</u>: Possession of a valid license to operate a motor vehicle in New York State.
