

Westchester County Human Rights Law Prohibits

DISCRIMINATION

in

PLACES OF PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION

ON THE BASIS OF: Actual or perceived differences, including those based on race, color, religion, ethnicity, creed, age, national origin, alienage or citizenship status, familial status, gender, marital status, sexual orientation and disability as well as victims or those who are perceived to be victims of domestic violence, sexual abuse or stalking.

BY: Licensed or unlicensed providers of goods, facilities, services, accommodations, advantages, privileges of any kind, or where goods, facilities, services, accommodations, advantages or privileges are offered, sold, or otherwise made available and extended to the public. This includes, but is not limited to, hotels, restaurants, theaters, professional offices, places of entertainment, shops, stores, public transportation, banks, and government offices

EXEMPT: Any club or organization which is distinctly private, as defined in the Westchester County Human Rights Law.

OR: To advertise, inquire or use in an application for the sale, purchase, rental, lease or sub-lease of any property, any language that expresses or appears to express a limitation or indication of discrimination.

REMEDY MAY INCLUDE: Cease and desist order or monetary compensation.

Note: Newspapers and trade journals cannot publish advertisements which discriminate against persons in violation of the Westchester County Human Rights Law.

If you believe you have been denied access to any public facility, refused service, treated unfairly, harassed or asked to pay more or meet more difficult standards than others seeking the same accommodation, you may want to consider contacting the Westchester County Human Rights Commission. Any complaint of discrimination must be filed within one (1) year of the alleged discriminatory act.
