From California to Canada, couples are saying, “I do.” Here in New York our out-of-state marriages are finally recognized. But what does it really mean for us legally and financially? What is at stake with the marriage measure on the California ballot in November? How does a couple go about getting married in Canada or elsewhere? In the fall of 2004 Robert and Michael had the unusual distinction of being able to celebrate their 1<sup>st</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> anniversaries in the same year.
