Your health insurance will cover (with rare exceptions):

- Osteoporosis (bone density) screening
- Breast Cancer Screening (including yearly mammograms for women over age 40)
- Cervical Cancer Screening (Pap Smear)
- Prescription (FDA-approved) Birth Control methods

Family Planning Benefits Program (FPBP)

FREE

- Screening for sexually transmitted infections and cervical cancer (pap smear)
- Pregnancy Testing and counseling
- Emergency Contraception
- Birth Control Methods (pills, the patch, IUD, condoms)
- Male and female sterilization procedures
- Related lab tests
- HIV testing and counseling

Eligibility

- New York State resident
- Social Security number
- Income at or below 250% of Federal Poverty Level

Free Mammograms and Pap Smears

1. Women over age 40 need annual mammograms
2. For those without health insurance, call the Westchester County Department of Health's Breast Health Program at (914) 813-5260 to schedule a mammogram
3. Free Pap smears are also available to those who qualify.
