The Westchester County Department of Public Works is recruiting for several Auto Mechanics/Truck Mechanics to participate in the repair and maintenance of Westchester County's fleet of close to 2,000 heavy and light motor vehicles, heavy and small-motorized equipment. We are currently recruiting for the senior level Auto Mechanic that requires the highest level of NYS endorsement; however, we are also interested in candidates who possess varying degrees of experience and endorsements who with proper licensure, can aspire to the senior level.

Salaries range from \$60,920 – 73,595, depending on experience. All candidates must possess a high school diploma, general equivalency diploma, or an automotive trade school diploma.

- > Entry-level candidates must possess two years of regularly assigned automotive repair work experience.
- > **Journey-level candidates** must possess three years of regularly assigned automotive repair work experience.

Endorsements required are a valid Air Conditioning Recycling License, issued by an EPA approved organization and a New York State Motor Vehicle Inspector License with Light vehicle certification.

Senior-level candidates must possess a valid CDL "A" license and four of years of regularly assigned automotive diagnostic and repair work experience, one year of which must have been on heavy motor equipment; or eight years of the experience as noted, including the one year of specialized experience with heavy motor equipment.

Endorsements required are a Tow Truck Endorsement and Medical Examiner's Certificate for Interstate driving, a New York State Motor Vehicle Inspector License with Light vehicle, Heavy vehicle, and Motorcycles endorsements, and a valid Air Conditioning Recycling License, issued by an EPA approved organization.

For all candidates, 30 credits of post-high school education in the field of automotive repair or maintenance may substitute for one year of general automotive experience.
